Registration and Weigh-ins: All wrestlers must register and weigh-in by the time listed above for their age group. Wrestlers must wear a singlet during weigh-ins and no weight allowance is given for the singlet. Remember that there is no weight allowance given for the State Tournament and all wrestlers must make the same weight class that they qualified at, at the Qualifiers. Parents: Your wrestler must be in his/her singlet before entering the registration line. There is no area available for changing during the weigh-in process. Parents will be responsible for their child's belongings during the registration/weigh-in procedure

Parking Fee: Alliant Energy Center collects a daily parking fee. **There is also parking in the back of the arena.**

No food and beverage coolers are allowed in the Alliant Center.

Mat Assignments: Wrestlers will be assigned to a set of mats for each session. Please check the attached sheet for mat assignments. Wrestlers will be assigned bout numbers for their bouts on their chart. Please look at the score clocks for your mats to see what bout numbers are being wrestled on your set of mats and when they are about 5 bouts times the number of mats your group is using away from your bout number please go to the staging area where they will need to look at the Projection Screens for their mat assignment once their assignment is shown then they can proceed to the mat they are assigned to through the floor entrance with their 2 coaches.

Awards will be given out right after wrestler's placement match is complete. As soon as match is finished they should exit arena floor to the north by mat 16. We will organize each age and weight class there and take them as a group to the awards areas.

Name and Club Corrections for Program .All the Qualifiers will be run on Trackwrestling and results will be on the WWF website by Midnight Saturday March 21st and a list of all qualifiers will also be posted on the WWF web site by Sunday Morning. Please look at the Qualifiers List by Sunday March 22nd Midnight to make sure that your name is spelled right and the club is correct. If it is not please email Jeff Jones at jeffjones99@att.net or call 262-424-3672 and leave a message. The names and clubs will be going in the program exactly the way they are on the web site as of Monday morning the 18th. The brackets will not be posted anywhere until the day of the event before weigh-ins.

IN ORDER TO BE ALLOWED MATSIDE TO COACH AT THE WWF KIDS FOLKSTYLE STATE TOURNAMENT, ONE MUST BE A CURRENT USA WRESTLING COACH MEMBER AND HAVE A COPPER COACHES CERTIFICATION OR HIGHER. THIS INCLUDES PARENTS, CLUB COACHES, ETC.

Individuals 18 years of age and older must successfully complete a mandatory background check before purchasing USA Wrestling Coaches Membership. Please allow 7-10 business days for the background check process, as USA Wrestling Coaches Memberships will not be available on-site.

All USA Wrestling member coaches will receive free admission to the WWF State Folkstyle Championships. Coach's entrance will be by both entrances and will only be Friday and Saturday 8:30-11am. In order to receive free admission and floor access, proof of coach membership and certification AND a photo ID will be required.

One adult without a USA Wrestling Coach Membership will be allowed to accompany a wrestler to the arena floor if no coach is available but must enter the arena floor with the wrestler. This adult will not be allowed to coach and must stay within the designated area along the arena wall. This is being done to ensure that youth wrestlers will be accompanied by someone.

Wrestlers that are not assigned to a mat are not allowed on the arena floor.

Warning: Singlets and head gear is required, The Qualifier sites will be enforcing the WIAA finger nail length rule. Hair length rule for Boys and Girls. The hair must be off the collar in back, not being below the ear lobe on the side or the eye brows in front. If it is too long they must get it cut or wear a bonnet. If you chose to not wear a bonnet, putting your hair in a bun on top of your head is acceptable and must be secured with a rubber band, pony tails will not be legal. No hard or abrasive items are eligible for securing any hair that exceeds the hair length rule. . They also will enforce the WIAA mouth guard rule for wrestlers with braces. Also Skin Checks will be done. Girls must wear a female cut singlet or wear an approved undergarment underneath their singlet.
