Covid-19 Tournament Protocols

Everyone must wear face mask or shield except wrestlers during matches

Everyone's temperature will be taken as they enter the building and fill out USA Wrestling Covid Questionnaire.

Only one coach matside per wrestler.

Wrestlers and coaches cannot enter the floor area until they are assigned to a mat and leave the area as soon as their match is completed. One way traffic – Enter on sides and exit at the ends.

There will sanitizing stations throughout the building

Awards - Custom Trophies 1st-6th. In 8 man brackets and larger awards will be given out at the mats when placement matches are completed. Champions, please come to the head table for their awards chart. 5 man brackets and smaller will be given out at the head table please come up when your bracket is complete. There will be an awards backdrop setup for individual pictures. We are doing this because everyone knows how congested awards areas can be.

Admission – Only immediate family members are allowed to attend because of Covid-19 occupancy restrictions.

Adults (9th Grade and older) \$10.00 per day

Children (K-8th) \$5.00 per day

Under 5 years old, Competitors and Coaches with USAW Leaders Cards Free

Coaches Passes: Coaches must buy a Coaches Band to coach mat side \$10.00 for all Sessions. Only one coach allowed mat side per wrestler per our Covid-19 procedures put in place

Trackcast - All matches will be trackcasted so people that could not be here can watch the matches for \$15.00. All first place matches will be announced during the matches. Winners of the Semi Finals will receive a Bio Sheet from the mat side table. Please fill it out and return it to the head table right away so the announcer can get to know the wrestler.

First Available Mat - Matches will be assigned to a mat by first available mat. All matches for a session will assigned a 4 digit number starting with _001 and we will work our way up until the session is completed. There will mat assignment screens set around the dome and they also be seen on your electronic devices.

Wrestling Rules - We follow WIAA rules except the time periods are 90 seconds for the Born in 2006-07 Boys and Girls, the rest of the divisions are 3 -60 second periods. Singlets or approved two-piece uniform and head gear is required. They also will enforce the WIAA mouth guard rule for wrestlers with braces. Also skin checks will be done. Girls must wear a female cut singlet or wear an approved undergarment underneath their singlet.

Weighins – All wrestlers must show their USA Wrestling card at weigh-ins. If you do not have one please buy one on usawmembership.com. Wrestlers can only weigh-in at the time listed for their group. If 2 different times are listed for a group they only have to weigh-in once. The weights listed are the maximum you can weigh in that weight class. Wrestlers will be put in the group they weighed in for and can go up or down from their registered weight. Only one person is allowed to accompany the wrestler into weigh-ins.
