

Wilton JV & Women's Wrestling Tournament

Saturday, December 18th, 2021

Participating Schools: Anamosa, Bettendorf, Columbus Jct., Davenport Central, Davenport North, Davenport West, English Valleys, Fairfield, Iowa City West, Marion, Maquoketa, MFL-MarMac (Girl's), Mid-Prairie, Monticello, Mt. Pleasant, Mt. Vernon, Muscatine, North Scott, Northeast, North Cedar, Solon, Tipton, West Liberty, Williamsburg and Wilton.

Entry Fee: \$75 per team

Coaches: The tournament will be bracketed via Track Wrestling. Track's normal procedure for entering wrestlers will be used. You will be contacted with the link to the track wrestling site. If you have any questions, please email Coach Boorn at gabeboorn@wiltoncsd.org. We will be using Track Wrestling to run the tournament, as required by state mandate. Please include your wrestlers name, grade, sex and actual weight, rating (1-3, 1 being the best) and school. We are also wrestling a girls division(s) within our tournament. We will group the girls with the closest weight classes as possible.

WE WILL BE WRESTLING 5 MATS IN 2 GYMS. Be prepared as your wrestlers may be in separate gyms and will be on one mat for the entire day.

Hospitality Room: There will be a coaches/officials hospitality room available. Coaches will be required to get a mark on their hand prior to the start of wrestling to be able to enter the hospitality room.

Weigh In: Weigh your kids on Thursday night or Friday morning and they will be grouped together by actual weights and rating where possible into 4 man round robin. To meet state guidelines we will weigh-in wrestlers on site between 7:30 and 8:30 a.m. Coaches when you arrive, weigh in your wrestlers for your records. Please report any scratches as soon as possible by calling or texting Coach Boorn @ 563-210-0872 with any scratches Friday night or early Saturday morning.

COACHES' MEETING WILL FOLLOW WEIGH-INS at 8:30 AM (in the hospitality room)

Wrestling starts at 9:30 & MATCHES: 1-2-2

Concessions will be available throughout the day. No outside coolers, roasters, microwaves, etc. allowed.

Locker rooms will not be monitored, but will be assigned. There is a separate locker room for all female wrestlers. Have your wrestlers remove all their gear after changing. Wilton Community School District is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

Bus Parking: Buses- please drop your wrestlers off at the south entrance of the High School Gym then pull around the school to the East side of the building and parking will be available between the school and softball/baseball complex on the gravel lot. There will be a coach at the East doors of the auditorium to let bus drivers in.

Round 1: All 4 man brackets (approx. 2 hrs.)
(Brackets split evenly between both gyms and on all 5 mats)

Round 2: All Brackets (approx. 2 hrs.)
(All brackets and wrestlers will remain on the same mat as first round)

Round 3: All Brackets (approx. 2 hrs.)
(All brackets and wrestlers will remain on the same mat as first round)

(Some brackets may shift mats as other mats wrestle to completion)

Medals awarded to the top 2 wrestlers in each bracket.
