### Registration

- A current MN/USA card is required to register and participate in the tournament
- Register only on <u>Trackwrestling.com</u>. Wrestlers will not be able to register at the door.
- Registration is currently open, and closes Friday, January 7 at 8:00 p.m.
- The cost is \$17.00 per wrestler (no refunds if you do not compete at the tournament for any reason).
- If your wrestler pulls out of the tournament, please call, or send an email to the tournament director, so we are not waiting for your wrestler to start the session.

#### Admission

- \$5.00 per person at the door (children under 6 are free).
- Cash only accepted at the admissions table.

# Weigh-Ins and Weight Audit

- We will not be doing a full on-site weigh-in of every wrestler.
- During registration parents/guardians will enter the wrestler's weight. This is what will be used to pre-create the brackets.
- We are using the "Honor System" and expect parents/guardians to correctly select their wrestler's weight class.
- We will be doing random weight audits of several brackets each session. During check-in, selected wrestlers will be sent over to the weight audit table.
- The wrestler's weight needs to be within 3% of the weight submitted during registration. For example, if a parent/guardian registered their wrestler at 50 lbs, their wrestler can weigh no more than 51.5 lbs.
- If a wrestler is over-weight, the parent/guardian and wrestler must report to the head table immediately. The wrestler will then be removed from the tournament and no refund will be given.

## Brackets & Additional Information

- We will be using 4-Man Brackets. Our goal is to get all wrestlers at least 3 matches.
- We are placing 1st 4th place. All wrestlers will receive a medal.
- There will be concessions on-site all day long. Cash will be accepted.
- We follow the School District 624 policies. At this time masks are required within all schools in the district. Masks will not be required for wrestlers during their matches.
