4 Man Round Robin bracketed by age, weight, and experience (No weigh-ins. Be honest, as you can be challenged (\$5 CHALLENGE FEE) and must be within 3 pounds of weight (no extra pounds). If not, wrestlers will have to forfeit out of tournament. (NO REFUNDS)

Novice is defined as 1st or 2nd year wrestlers ONLY! 3rd year wrestlers can only wrestle novice if they had a losing record the previous year. (Honesty is expected)

Open Tournament: 8U, 10U, 12U, & 14U

NEUSA Weight Classes will be used with a 2LB allowance due to the holiday weekend. We will combine if needed.

RULES: Double elimination, wrestle back tournament. We will do our best to separate teammates if possible. Birth Certificates must be available if challenged.

Three 60 second periods, with sudden victory over time in Elementary Three 90 second periods, with sudden victory overtime in Middle School NHSAA & OMAWA youth rules will apply with certified officials
