Eligibility for the Event

*All IKWF/USA carded Kids who have only USA cards that begin with 23 or 24 and ALL TOTS regardless of their USA card number

Your USA number needs to start with 23 or 24 unless you’re a TOT if it doesn’t you will be removed and NOT refunded.

If you enter the event and it is determined that you are NOT a beginner you will be removed and NO REFUNDS

*All participants must be residents of the state of Illinois (no out of state wrestlers allowed)

*Wrestlers who register for this event and are deemed ineligible will be removed and NOT refunded

The following are the divisions for the event

- ❖ Tots (6 years old and under IKWF aged)-4 man Round Robin
- ❖ Bantam (7 & 8 IKWF aged wrestlers)-4-man Round Robin
- ❖ Intermediate (9 & 10 IKWF aged wrestlers)-4-man Round Robin
- ❖ Novice (11 & 12 IKWF aged wrestlers)-4-man Round Robin
- ❖ Senior (13 & 14 IKWF aged wrestlers/NOT in H.S.)-4-man Round Robin
- ❖ Girls Divisions 1 (8 years olds and younger IKWF age)- 4 man Round Robin
- ❖ Girls Divisions 2 (9-10-11 years olds IKWF age)- 4 man Round Robin
- ❖ Girls Divisions 3 (12 and above years olds IKWF age)- 4 man Round Robin

Only 500 wrestlers TOTAL will be allowed in this event

ALL DIVISIONS ARE BLOCKED WEIGHTS

Walk-up registrations at MAIN weigh-in location ONLY.

NO walk-up registrations at satellite locations (unless approved by Tournament Director prior to March 23, 2024)

Weigh-ins: Saturday March 24, 2024-TIMES & Satellite locations to be announced
Walk ups and late registrations on Saturday March 25, 2023 and on Sunday March 26, 2023 from 6:30 am until 7:00 am at Richards HS.

All wrestlers must weigh-in wearing a competition singlet.

All wrestlers must pass hair, fingernail, skin condition checks prior to weigh-in.

All questionable skin conditions must be reported on the IHSA Skin Condition Form and brought to weigh-ins.

Weigh-ins

Sites: To be determined and announced and posted on the Pre-Registration page on Trackwrestling for this event

Wrestling: Sunday March 24, 2024 only. **Wrestling will begin at approximately 8:30 am** for ALL divisions on assigned mats.

Coaching: All coaches must have a current 2023-24 USA coach's card and that card must be properly displayed along with a copper/bronze/silver or gold USA wrestling certification card.

Spectator
Admission:

Adults (14 years old and up): \$6,
Children (6 to 13 years old) & Coaches; \$4,
Children under 5 years old are FREE.

Officials: All officials are registered with the United States Wrestling Officials Association (USWOA).

Rules: National Federation of State High School rules with IKWF modifications.

Notes: *A wrestler can compete in only ONE division.

***FULL Mats for wrestling-ALL DIVISIONS**

Divisions: The age of every wrestler in the tournament is determined by their age on December 31, 2023. according to your age on the IKWF roster

The following are the divisions for the event

- ❖ Tots (6 years old and under IKWF aged)-4 man Round Robin
- ❖ Bantam (7 & 8 IKWF aged wrestlers)-4-man Round Robin
- ❖ Intermediate (9 & 10 IKWF aged wrestlers)-4-man Round Robin
- ❖ Novice (11 & 12 IKWF aged wrestlers)-4-man Round Robin
- ❖ Senior (13 & 14 IKWF aged wrestlers/NOT in H.S.)-4-man Round Robin
- ❖ Girls Divisions 1 (8 years olds and younger IKWF age)- 4 man Round Robin
- ❖ Girls Divisions 2 (9-10-11 years olds IKWF age)- 4 man Round Robin
- ❖ Girls Divisions 3 (12 and above years olds IKWF age)- 4 man Round Robin

Bracketing: 4-man Round Robin blocked weights for Open Divisions
*All bracketing dependent on the number of entries and weights from weigh-ins.

Awards: Medals 1st & 2nd place ONLY----**ALL DIVISIONS**

Bout Time: 1 min., 1 min., 1 min. (no rest between periods). IKWF OT rules/procedures in place.
