

# Utah 1A-4A Jr High/Middle School State Championships

Friday/Saturday, January 17<sup>th</sup> and 18<sup>th</sup> 2025 – Sevier Valley Center, 100 South 800 West Richfield UT

**Brackets/Divisions:** Brackets will be line brackets for all weight classes. There are separate divisions for Middle School (4<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> Grade) and Junior High (7<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> Grade) wrestlers.

- Boys Division
  - Middle School 4th 5th & 6th graders  
Weights: 57, 61, 64, 67, 70, 73, 76, 80, 83, 86, 90, 93, 96, 100, 106, 113, 120, 126, 138, 150, 170, 285
  - Jr. High 7th 8th & 9th graders  
Weights: 70, 75, 80, 85, 90, 93, 96, 100, 104, 108, 112, 116, 120, 124, 128, 132, 138, 145, 155, 170, 190, 210, 285
  
- Girl's Division
  - Middle School 4th 5th & 6th graders  
Weights: 60, 70, 80, 90, 100, 116, 132, 150, 170, 285
  - Jr. High 7th 8th & 9th graders  
Weights: 70, 80, 90, 100, 115, 130, 150, 170, 210, 285

**Period Lengths:** 1:30 for All Rounds

**Admissions:** \$10 for adults, \$5 for students and seniors for a single day pass. \$15 for adults, and \$10 for students and seniors for a two day pass. Doors will open at 2:00pm on Friday and 7:30am on Saturday.

**Floor Access:** Coaches only on the floor. Parents will need to stay in the stands. If you do not have a coaching band, you will not be allowed on the floor.

**Gear/Food:** There will be shirts, hoodies, hats, etc available for purchase on site. The Sevier Valley Center will run their own concessions for the event.

**Seeding:** All wrestlers will be seeded the best we can, with the information provided during registration and criteria available. Seeding criteria is: Head to head (current season), 2024 State Placing (Jr High supersedes Middle School), Season Record, 2023 State Placing, Common Opponents, Previous Head to head. Brackets will be preset before the coaches meeting, and the meeting will address only major errors or oversights.

**Make sure you add your wrestler's seeding criteria when you register! Without it, they will not likely be seeded.**

**Awards:** Medals for 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> place.

The Middle School and Jr. High divisions will be combined for team awards. Team points will be calculated based on the highest placer in each of the 45 boys weights to give one overall state championship in each of the classifications (1A, 2A, 3A, 4A). The tournament team points will be an accumulation of activity, advancement, and placement points. 1st & 2nd teams in each classification will be presented Trophies. First and second place girls' trophies will be presented to the top two girls teams

**Sanctioned Event/Registration/Deadline:** \$25 pre-registration fee. Onsite registration is accepted up until the end of weigh-ins at a fee of \$100 (please preregister so we can keep this event organized). Your registered team must be based on your team's affiliation or high school that your program feeds into. No high school freshmen who have wrestled one high school match are eligible to participate. No All-Star teams/clubs are eligible to compete for awards. **Weigh-Ins:** All Weigh-ins will take place at the Sevier Valley Center on January 17<sup>th</sup> between 7 am and 12 pm. All wrestlers must weigh in a legal wrestling singlet. If a wrestler does not make their registered weight and desires to change weight a \$20 change of weight class fee will be assessed. No changes to weight class will be allowed after the weigh-in window closes. Wrestlers are eligible for the weight class they weigh-in at and one weight class up. Wrestlers cannot choose to move up more than one weight class. No running off weight or other visible means to lose weight will be allowed at the facility.

There will be a skin & nail check on all wrestlers @ weigh-ins. High School grooming and communicable disease rules apply. A Dr's note is needed for any communicable disease stating it is no longer in the contagious stage. Headgear and Legal Uniform are required (same as high school).

Wristbands will be made in advance with Team name on them. You will be issued a given number of wrist bands based on your team registration numbers.

**Tournament Schedule (Please arrive 30 minutes prior to your mat. Schedule may adjust based on final numbers)**

- **Friday January 17<sup>th</sup>**
  - 7:00am – 12:00pm: Weigh-In for ALL wrestlers.
  - 1:00pm-3:00pm: Coaches meeting for each division.
  - 3:45pm: Parade of Teams (Middle School Wrestlers)
  - 4:00pm – Wrestling begins – Middle School (3 rounds of Championship & Consolation)
  - 5:45pm: Parade of Teams (Junior High Wrestlers)
  - 6:00pm: Wrestling Begins – Junior High (3 rounds of Championship & Consolation)
- **Saturday January 18<sup>th</sup>**
  - 9:00am: Wrestling Begins – BOTH Middle School and Junior High Divisions
    - Wrestling will continue until the finals
    - The Championship Round will be wrestled as soon as we get to that portion of the tournament. There will be no set time.
    - Weight classes that only have 2 wrestlers will not wrestle each other until the finals.

\*This is a double elimination tournament. You will find your posted bracket sheets located on the upper deck of the arena. Do not leave Friday night until you are sure you are finished wrestling. If you leave early, your matches will be forfeited.

\*Only two coaches are allowed per corner. No video, media, stat managers are allowed on the floor of the arena.
