We are happy that you have chosen to attend the 2025 Lander Wrestling Tournament. There are some changes to this year's format.

Varsity Boys and Girls will wrestle in the Fieldhouse and Aux Gym in a bracketed tournament. We will allow more than two varsity entries per team per weight.

The Junior Varsity will have its own bracketed tournament taking place at Pathfinder High School. We will not be running our second chance tournament this year. Pathfinder High School is located at 863 Sweetwater Street; please use the sidewalk on Sweetwater to enter the gym. Do not go through our main Central Administration entrance.

Beginning with the first round we will wrestle through the quarterfinal round in the championship bracket. Time permitting we will wrestle through the fourth round wrestle backs in the consolation bracket. If we run too long, we will begin Saturday with fourth round wrestle backs.

Rounds will be as follows:

1. First round championship bracket
2. Second round championship bracket and first round wrestle backs
3. Second Round Wrestle Backs
4. Quarterfinal round in the championship bracket and third round wrestle backs
5. Fourth round wrestle backs (time permitting)

Saturday, January 25

8:00 Weigh In (Varsity Boys and Girls Only)

8:30 JV Tournament begins and will run until completed to ensure it finishes ahead of the Varsity Boys and Girls Tournament.

9:20 Wrestling begins for Varsity Boys and Girls in the Fieldhouse.

Rounds will be as follows:

1. Semifinals in the championship bracket and fifth round wrestle backs
2. Semi consolations
3. Medal rounds on three mats

Awards will be given out following the conclusion of the heavyweight bouts. JV, Girls Varsity and Boys Varsity will place through fourth place individually with bracket winners receiving a tournament t-shirt. Varsity Boys and Varsity Girls will place the top three teams.

We will only break long enough for table workers and mat officials to eat and to wash mats. If we get behind in either tournament we will push through tournament breaks to catch up.

Seeding Criteria: Seeding Meeting will be held at 10:05am in the LVHS Health/PE Room.

1. Head to Head victory
2. 2024 State Place
3. 2024 Lander Invite Place
4. 2024 Regional Place
5. 2023 State Place
6. Varsity record against quality competition
7. Coin Flip/Common Sense

Admission: One day passes are \$5.00 for adults and \$2.00 for students, all tournament passes are \$7.00 for adults and \$3.00 for students.

Bus Parking and Drop Off: Buses may drop athletes off on the southwest side of the fieldhouse gym. Please park buses on the south end of the parking lot toward Baldwin Creek Road.

Reminders:

- Athletes and coaches please police your area. We will provide trash bags in your team packet to pick up garbage.
- Team camps need to be set up in the hallway past the auxiliary gym.
- Seating will be crowded, so please limit coolers to team camp areas.
- Coaches please keep your athletes contained in the fieldhouse, auxiliary gym, lobby, and locker room areas. We have school still in session, so athletes should not be in the main school building.
- A hospitality room will be provided in the wrestling room for coaches and bus drivers.
- If you have a scale available for weigh-ins, please bring it. We would like to run seven scales to weigh-in athletes.

- Coaches will be emailed entry passwords. We will enter Varsity and JV athletes into TRACK Wrestling. We plan to live broadcast all varsity matches on Track Wrestling, please inform your athletes and parents of this service.
- We do not provide towels.
