

2025 OREGON MIDDLE SCHOOL WRESTLING

STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

DATE: Saturday, March 15th, 2025. Doors open at 6:30AM; **Girls start at 8:00AM; boys start at 1:00PM.**

LOCATIONS: **West Albany HS** - Oregon Middle School State Championship website: <https://omsswc.com/>

ADMISSION: **\$5 entry fee for coaches and spectators** (under 6 years of age are free)

REGISTRATION: **\$30 per wrestler.** Cash/check payable at weigh-ins. To be able to wrestle in this tournament you must qualify from the correct regional tournament. There will be **separate boys and girls brackets**. Wrestlers participate under assigned middle school in corresponding county, not the club in which they may participate. **School ID required.** If a participant's school does not issue an ID, print some proof of enrollment which includes the student's grade level (e.g. report card). Homeschoolers can bring comparable verification of grade. Homeschoolers will register under the middle school they would have been assigned to attend.

WEIGH-INS: Friday, March 14th, 2025, from 4:00 - 7:00PM at **West Albany HS.** For those who cannot make the Friday weigh in, a short boys Saturday weigh in is possible from 10:00 - 10:30AM at **West Albany HS.** Wrestlers have to make the weight that they qualified for at their regional tournament. If they do not make the weight they qualified for they will not be allowed to go up to the next weight and will not be able to participate in the tournament. OSAA weigh-in rules will be in effect. Wrestlers will **weigh-in wearing approved uniforms** (singlet or compression shirt with shorts). There are no check scales and absolutely no weight cutting at the facility or leaving the weigh-in area once you enter. If a wrestler does not pass their skin check, an "OSAA Medical Release for Wrestlers to Participate with Skin Lesion" will be required at the time of weigh-ins. NOTE: Any wrestler choosing to challenge available scales will not be allowed to leave the weigh-in area until the challenge is concluded. Wrestlers are not allowed to remove clothing prior to or during the challenge process. Participation in dehydration activities will not be allowed.

WEIGHTS:

- **Boys** - 75, 80, 85, 90, 95, 102, 110, 117, 125, 132, 140, 150, 160, 175, 195, 220, 275
- **Girls** - 80, 90, 95, 100, 105, 110, 115, 120, 125, 135, 145, 155, 170, 185, 220

SEEDING: ¹Champions from each regional qualifier will be seeded 1-5 based on ²previous place at the 2024 Middle School State Tournament and ³total points scored at regionals. The 2nd place regional qualifiers will be placed on the opposite side of the bracket from their regional champion and the remaining qualifiers will be a randomly drawn into the bracket.

FORMAT: There will be 16 wrestlers in each bracket. **Both boys and girls must now qualify at the regional tournaments.** No changes will be made to the brackets to avoid teammates or previous opponents. Top 6 placers at state receive medals. There will be 4 team trophies for boys and 4 team trophies for girls.

COACHES PASSES: Coach's wrist bands may be picked up/signed out by **head coaches of each school** on Saturday, March 15th based on the number of participants from each middle school per OSAA rules.

OFFICIALS: OSAA certified officials will be at the tournament.

OTHER INFO:

- Headgear is required and shoelaces must be secured
- Only two coaches can be in the corner; no other spectators allowed mat side
- Unsportsmanlike conduct by any individual may result in immediate removal from the premises
 - Coaches are expected to encourage good sportsmanship from parents
- Team score will be compiled for both the boy's tournament and girl's tournament
- Concessions and tournament shirts and hoodies will be available for purchase
