- **Custodians:** A full-time custodian will be available to maintain cleanliness, address spills, handle refills, and manage accidents to keep the event running smoothly.
- **Tournament Director:** Our tournaments are renowned for their organization and punctuality, led by our exceptional director, Ronda Pavlenko. We invest in resources to ensure systems like Trackwrestling operate seamlessly without interruptions.
- Officials and Table Workers: We will utilize AIA-certified officials. All tournaments will be managed through Trackwrestling, with TVs and laptops set up at each table for seamless operation. Table workers will consist of volunteers from Queen Creek/ Manu WC, providing them with valuable hands-on experience in running events.
