**Trainers:** A certified trainer in the gym to provide aid, administer ice, and treat injuries as needed. This ensures the safety of all participants in this high-contact sport.

**Security:** A certified security guard, hired through the school district, will manage crowd control, handle incident reports, and oversee the overall safety of wrestlers, officials, coaches, and spectators.

**Custodians:** A full-time custodian will be available to maintain cleanliness, address spills, handle refills, and manage accidents to keep the event running smoothly.

**Tournament Director:** Our tournaments are renowned for their organization and punctuality, led by our exceptional director, Ronda Pavlenko. We invest in resources to ensure systems like Trackwrestling operate seamlessly without interruptions.

**Officials and Table Workers:** We will utilize AIA-certified officials. All tournaments will be managed through Trackwrestling, with TVs and laptops set up at each table for seamless operation. Table workers will consist of volunteers from Queen Creek/ Manu WC, providing them with valuable hands-on experience in running events.

7am-8am 6u, 8u, 8uR, 10u, 10uR, 12u, 12uR, Girls PK-2, Girls 3-4

9am-10am 14u, 16u, 18u, JH Girls, HS Girls

There are no satellite or early weigh-ins

## Start Times

9:00am Start 6u, 8u, 8uR, 10u, 10uR, 12u, 12uR, Girls PK-2, Girls 3-4

11:30am 14u, 16u, 18u, JH Girls, HS Girls

Your age at the time of the event will determine the division in which you will compete. Coed Rookie Divisions-Madison Bracketed

8u, 10u, 12u-All coed-rookie and girls' divisions will use Madison bracketing. If there are no available competitors near your wrestler's weight, they may be placed in the regular division or moved up one age group. If the weight difference is too great, adjustments will be made as necessary. This process ensures that all athletes compete within safe and appropriate weight and age ranges.

10u: 60, 65, 70, 75, 85, 100, 125

12u: 75, 80, 85, 95, 105, 115, 135, 175

14u: 85, 95, 105, 115, 125, 135, 145, 160, 175, 195, 285

16u: 105, 115, 125, 135, 145, 160, 175, 195, 285

18u: 115, 125, 135, 145, 160, 175, 195, 220, 285

Please note that some weight classes may be combined to ensure full brackets of 6+

## All-Girls Weight Classes-Madison Bracketed

Girls PK-2: 50, 60, 70

Girls 3-4: 60, 70, 95

Girls JH 5-8: 75, 85, 95, 105, 120, 135, 160

Girls HS 9-12: 105, 115, 125, 140, 155, 175, 235

We will run the tournament on 8-12 wrestling mats and 2 gymnasiums.

## Folkstyle Periods:

1-1-1 6u-12u/Girls PK-2 and 3-4

1:30-1-1 14u-18u and Girls JH and HS/ Consolation 1-1-1

To help keep the tournament running smoothly, we will not be pausing competition for warmups.

Wrestlers are responsible for warming up on their own in the hallways or outside using basic calisthenics.

#### MANDATORY WAIVER FORM

All wrestlers must print this form and bring it to every tournament in order to participate. You will need a new form for every tournament. The form must be turned in at weigh-ins.
