E. **PRE-TOURNAMENT SEEDING**

Each team will have the opportunity to enter their top two athletes at each weight classification.

By Tuesday, February 4th (mid-night) teams must submit roster and appropriate documentation to assist in seeding to asears@vashonsd.org.

By Thursday, February, 6th (3:00 PM) the Tournament Director will email a draft of seeds to coaches and athletic directors. If possible, disputed seeds will be remedied over email. If unresolved, a coaches vote or coin flip (see criteria for seeding below) will be held at the coaches meeting before the tournament.

Seeding to the sub-regional tournament will occur in the following way:

1. CRITERIA FOR SEEDING VARSITY WRESTLERS

- A. Best record against district opponents (NL and OL 1A teams) considering ... most wins 1st ... least losses 2nd and head-to-head.
- B. If head-to-head didn't occur or is tied, then common opponent record would be considered next.
- C. State credentials (State participant, placer or champion)
- D. Coaches vote (In extenuating circumstances, coaches vote will supersede A, B & C)
- E. Coin flip

2. CRITERIA FOR SEEDING JV WRESTLERS

JV Wrestlers with winning varsity record will be seeded opposite their varsity wrestler (separate same schools) and then random draw.

Please place your athletes appropriately as any changes in weight classifications will require approval (vote) of the tournament committee after they are seeded into the tournament at the seeding meeting.

Skin check and Weigh-in 8:30 am in the locker room (please wait in gym until your team is called). Consideration of ferry schedules will be given for order of weigh-in.

2. Event workers on the pass list
3. Coaches will forward a pass list (attached) for support personnel (coaches, managers, statisticians, trainers, etc.) to the tournament director no later than Friday, February 7th (3 PM).
4. Cheer staff **in uniform** will be admitted free. However, each school will be limited to a maximum of four at mat side. Each school will be limited to eight cheerleaders and one cheer coach.

J. **AWARDS**

1. A pin will be awarded to the first through third place wrestlers in each weight class. Fourth through sixth place finishers will receive ribbons.
2. Individual awards will be presented immediately following the final match.
3. The team awards will be presented immediately following the final match to the first place and second place teams.

K. **REGIONAL QUALIFIERS**

The top 4 finishers at each weight classification will qualify for the Regional Tournament to be held at **Klahowya Secondary School on Saturday, February 15th, 2020.** The 5th place finisher will be the alternate to the Regional Tournament.

L. **OFFICIALS**

1. Officials will be assigned from the Western Washington Wrestling Officials Association.
2. The officials will be alternated throughout the entire tournament, including the finals.

M. **DISPUTES**

Any disputes occurring at the tournament will be presented to the Tournament Director, Andy Sears, and he will convene the Tournament Committee. Their decision will be final.

N. **SPECIAL PROBLEMS**

The Tournament Director is empowered to make any decisions and judgments deemed necessary that are not specifically covered by these instructions.

O. **MEET PROCEDURE INFORMATION**

1. **Locker Rooms**

- a. The locker rooms are available for wrestlers.
- b. **BE SURE:** (1) Wrestlers deposit all debris in waste cans

(2) Bulletin boards are left untouched

(3) Each coach will discuss the proper care of locker rooms and shower rooms with the team.

2. Each school or participant must furnish their own towels.

3. Valuables should NOT be left in the dressing rooms.

4. **Floor Restrictions**

a. No one will be permitted to stand along the mats, including coaches, wrestlers and spectators.

b. A coach, assistant coach, trainer, or manager will be permitted to sit in the chairs set inside the roped area while he has an athlete wrestling. The limit is two personnel (individuals) per school at mat side.

5. **News Media Photographers**

Only those approved by the Tournament Director will be allowed inside the mat area.

6. **Student Reporters and Photographers**

One photographer and one reporter per school will be allowed floor privileges. However, they must be identified by a letter from their school and the floor privileges cleared through the Tournament Manager.

7. **Signs**

No signs except official school banners will be allowed.

8. **Concessions**

The concession stand is a fundraiser for a Vashon High School Club. No Hospitality room will be provided for coaches and officials. Coffee will be provided free of charge.

9. **Trainers / First Aid**

A certified athletic trainer (CAE) will be on site. Participating teams will be required to provide needed supplies (tape, pre-wrap etc.).

10. **Publicity**

Final scores and place winners will be posted on WPAN.

P. **SPECIAL INTRODUCTION BEFORE CHAMPIONSHIP ROUND**

This procedure will be reviewed at the pre-tournament meeting.

Q. **TEAM SCORING**

Varsity and J.V. wrestlers score for their team.

1. **Team Placement**

First Place - 16 points

Third Place - 9 points

Fifth Place - 5 points

Second Place - 12 points

Fourth Place - 7 points

Sixth Place - 3 points

2. **Advancement Points**

a. Two team "advancement points" will be scored for each match won in the championship bracket, except for the final round. If a wrestler receives a bye in the first round, he will

be awarded two "advancement points" for that round if he wins his next match. No points are awarded for the bye if the wrestler loses his next match.

- b. One point will be awarded if you win the consolation bracket, except for the finals matches for 3rd and 5th places.

3. **Points for Defaults, Disqualification, Falls or Forfeits**

- a. Two additional points will be scored for each match won by default, disqualification, fall or forfeit throughout the tournament
- b. One and one-half points will be awarded for each match won by a technical fall.
- c. One point will be awarded for each match won by a major decision (8 - 14 points).

4. **Other Scoring**

- a. In tournament scoring six places, the winner of each championship semi-final shall be awarded twelve place points, and the winner of each championship final shall be awarded four additional place points. The winner of each consolation semi-final shall be awarded seven place points, and the winner of the third shall receive two additional place points.
- b. Two pin points automatic if meeting a teammate.
