**COACHES MEETING**: Our coaches meeting will take place in the main building following weigh-ins. **Saturday, 8:00 a.m., Main Building, Room B-163** 

**TOURNAMENT**: Our tournament will be a 16-man, double elimination, seeded tourney with placing matches through 5<sup>th</sup> place ran on Trackwrestling. We have also run a Junior Varsity Tournament as well, so teams are encouraged to bring both.

**IMPORTANT NOTE**: Each individual is limited to six (6) matches each day

**WRESTLING STARTING TIMES:** Saturday, December 3<sup>rd</sup> @ 9:00 a.m.

**SEEDING**: Seeding will be finalized immediately after weigh in and determined by the seeding criteria entered by the coaches in Trackwrestling. You will receive an email from Track providing a username and password so you can enter your wrestlers and seeding criteria. Please enter your wrestlers no later than November 30<sup>th</sup>, 2022. ## **OVERTIME AND MATCH LENGTH:**

Championship Bracket - 2, 2, 2 Consolation Bracket - 1, 2, 2

All Overtime Matches - All tied matches will be determined by the tie-breaker overtime criteria.

It shall consist of one, one-minute period followed by a 30 second sudden if death if necessary.

**PASSES**: Each team will receive one (1) pass per participant. Also, two (2) coaches passes, one (1) administrator pass, one (1) manager pass, and two (2) statistician passes. Cheerleaders **in uniform** will be admitted free. No extra passes will be issued.

**COACHES ROOM:** We will provide a variety of food and beverages throughout the day for coaches and officials. Coaches are welcome to go into the weight room to rest, eat, or visit at any time. Also, please note the tournament schedule. You will most likely **not** be able to take your wrestlers out to eat once we begin. It is your responsibility to provide nourishment for your wrestlers. Our volunteers will have a concession stand in operation.

**LODGING AND MEALS:** There are numerous restaurants located in Buckley and Enumclaw (5-10 minute drive). Also, there are motels to choose from in each city. Be aware that with sixteen (16) teams, there will be no breaks in the afternoon. Please plan ahead for your meals.

**TEAM AWARDS:** Trophies will awarded to the top three teams determined by team scoring.

**INDIVIDUAL AWARDS**: Medals will be awarded to the top four individual wrestlers in each weight class.

**OFFICIALS:** Officials will be from the Western Washington Officials Association
