Tournament Procedures

- Must Pre-Register on Track Wrestling by February 12, 2024
- Tournament Entry Fee:
 - \$30.00 per entry with a max of \$300.00 per school.
 - Payable to: Scappoose High School

MAILED CHECKS MUST BE RECEIVED BY February 15, 2024. Fees must be paid in order for the girls to wrestle. **No exceptions**. Refunds not given for cancellations.

- \circ Top 6 wrestlers will be recognized in each weight class
- Lower & upper weight outstanding wrestler
- Coach of the Year
- Top 3 teams will be recognized with a trophy/plaque
- Regional/Special District Meet Time Schedule: <u>Friday February, 16th</u>
 - 3:00 PM Weigh-in
 - 4:00 PM Doors and parking lot open to public (We are in school until 3:25 PM and we need to give the parking lot a chance to clear out.)
 - 5:00 PM Wrestling Starts

*We will not hold placing matches or finals matches. Prior to finals, we will take a 30-minute break to break down to 1 mat.

- Parking, check-in and passes
 - **PARKING:** All parking for buses will be in the Bus Parking & lower lot behind the school. Buses can drop teams at the bus turnaround in front of the school and then proceed to the bus parking.
 - CHECK IN: Signs will be displayed. All teams will check in and receive packets in the lobby of the gym. Teams will receive packets upon arrival. COACHES must be present at check-in with their athletes. Athletes may not check in without a coach and will not be allowed in the gymnasium without a pass.
 - We will have a designated area for teams to leave their belongings in our cafeteria and out of the bleachers. We will have a staff member in the cafeteria to make sure your things are taken care of. This will also give wrestlers a quieter place to hang out between matches if they would like to.
 - **Passes:** Packets will include participant passes for those registered and coaches passes based on the number of participants registered.
 - 1-3 (2 passes)
 - 4-7 (3 passes)
 - 8-11 (4 passes)
 - 12-15 (5 passes)
 - 16 or more (6 passes)
 - 0
- **NO exceptions.** Extra coaches passes are \$20.00. Cash or check only. No one, except wrestlers with passes and coaches with passes will be allowed behind the ropes on the main floor. Coaches must be OSAA Certified to receive a coach's pass.

• Admissions:

All people attending the tournament must enter on the West side of the building.

- Adults: \$10.00 per day
- Students/Children: \$5.00 per day

• THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES MUST BE USED FOR ALL REGIONAL/SPECIAL DISTRICT BY THE HOST SCHOOL. BRACKETING AND SEEDING MUST BE RUN ON "TRACK WRESTLING" AS PER OSAA

- Regional/Special District Championship will be determined at the Regional/Special District meet.
 - Each school may enter two wrestlers in each weight classification. This is a Varsity Only event. Please only submit entries of athletes competing for a spot in the state championships.
 - $\circ~$ If two wrestlers from the same school meet, pinpoints are automatically awarded.

- The Regional/Special District Wrestling Tournament will be a double-elimination tournament.
- The top **<u>five</u>** wrestlers will advance to the OSAA State Tournament.

• Conflict Criteria:

- Cross Bracketing will occur after the Quarterfinal round so that the losing wrestler stays in the same ½ bracket (small cross)
- Cross Bracketing will occur after the Championship Semifinals so that the losing wrestler moves to the other ½ bracket (large cross)
- Conflicts can occur after cross-bracketing in the 3rd Round Consolation and the Consolation Semifinals. When conflicts occur, wrestlers will be switched for the following reasons:
 - Have already wrestled in the Regional/Special District

• RegionalSpecial District Seeding.

- The 2 maximum entries per school per weight class will be entered into Track Wrestling by Wednesday night at 8:00 pm prior to RegionalSpecial District
- All girls only matches information for each school must be uploaded to Track Wrestling by Monday 8:00 pm prior to Regional/special District.
- Seeding will be done by Track Wrestling
- Coaches must indicate if their wrestler was a previous state placer when entering a wrestler on TrackWrestling into Regional/Special District.
- Verification of weigh-ins from each event and descent plan must be given to the Regional/Special District Tournament Director upon arrival at the tournament site.

• This event will be live-streamed on Flowrestling on both days

• Weigh-Ins

- Arrive with the team at least ½ hour prior to weigh-ins and turn in weight verifications.
- All athletes must be present at the start of weigh-ins.
- Friday is weight plus growth allowance +2 (Example: 100 lbs \rightarrow 102 lbs.)
- Saturday is an additional +1 and growth allowance (example: 100lbs \rightarrow 103lbs)
- If an athlete does not make weight in their registered weight class, that athlete is disqualified from the tournament.
