	<u>Alternates</u> : Alternates will be weighed in with the other competitors. Alternates will be placed in the bracket if the advancing wrestler is unable to attend. An advancing wrestler unable to compete due to injury, not making weight, or not being present at the start of weigh-ins can only be replaced from the alternates from his/her same qualifying tournament. An alternate not present at the start of weigh- ins for his/her respective weight class and not registered on the official weigh-in sheet cannot replace the advancing wrestler. Alternates are to be placed in the 4th qualifying position, moving other seeded wrestlers up one spot.		

	All information must be sent to the Regional Director by 4:00 p.m., Monday, February 5th, 2024.		
Tournament Packets	Will be available on Thursday February 8th for pick up between 3 pm to 5:00 pm or can be picked up Friday morning at the tournament. <b>Doors will close at 5:00</b> pm and all teams will need to leave at 5:00 pm if you are using mats for practice.		
Warm Up	Wrestlers will warm up under the west bleachers. An official will call wrestlers to the floor as needed. Only On-Deck and In-The-Hole Wrestlers will be allowed on the floor by the mat prior to the match. Prior to the beginning of each wrestling session, wresters will be permitted to warm up on the mats.		
Seeding Procedures	Wrestlers will be placed in brackets according to the a matrix of predefined brackets and guidelines that will be used are exactly as the one used for the state tournament.		
	<ol> <li>A draw will take place at 2:00 p.m. Monday, February 5<sup>th</sup>, for boys' district assignments to the predetermined bracket. The draw will be made for the weight class at which the match assignments will begin.</li> <li>The same procedure will take place for the girls.</li> </ol>		
Wrestle Back	Wrestle backs are allowed for advancement purposes only and only if the 4th and 5th place finishers have not previously faced each other in that tournament or if the 4th place finisher has not defeated the 5th place finisher in that tournament.		
Scoring	All places will be scored according to the National Federation rulebook.		
Medals/Awards	The top three places will receive individual medals. Team championship trophies will be presented along with outstanding wrestlers and UIL Region IV Coach of the Year and Assistant Coach of the Year trophies for girls and boys Outstanding Wrestler.		
Dressing Rooms	Four dressing rooms will be available for changing. Do not leave items in the dressing rooms.		
Hospitality	There will be a hospitality area for coaches, officials and tournament workers. Due to the limited seating in the hospitality room, it will mainly be a place to pick the food up and food can be consumed at your team area, official's room, or in the bleachers.
