Entries: Two (2) entries maximum per school, per weight class.

Seeding: We will be using TrackWrestling. Coaches have until 2/1/2024 at 5:00pm to enter wrestlers and seeding criteria. Seeding meeting will be held 2/1/2024 at 6:30pm at Hockinson HS or via zoom if needed. We will review the lineups and go over tournament information.

Weigh-in: February 3, 2024 at 8:00am on the Main Gym floor on mats 2 & 4. Weigh-in will be conducted by weight class. We will have one scale per mat.

Table Help: New this year, we would like to ask each school to work a score table during the day. This can be parents or volunteer coaches. Each volunteer will receive a white raffle ticket giving them 1 time access to hospitality room.

Spectators: Spectators will be seated on the top area of bleachers. Only team personnel with bracelets will be allowed on the gym floor. ***Strictly enforced this year!***

Valuables: Towels and locks will not be provided. Please have a team plan in place to guarantee the safety of your valuables. Tournament security and supervision will be on site but not responsible for lost items.

Awards: Medals will be awarded for 1st through 5th place in each weight class. All wrestlers will need to report to the awards podium in school uniform. No hats!

Regional: The top four (4) wrestlers in each weight class will advance to the Regional Championships at **Centralia High School on February 10, 2024.**

Hospitality: The hospitality room is for coaches, referees, and tournament staff as assigned by Hockinson Tournament Manager (Room 214). *ONLY approved wristbands will be allowed in this area.*

Food is not to be removed from the hospitality room for any reason.

Coaches: Each head coach and his/her staff will be responsible for the conduct of their team during the tournament. We ask for your cooperation in keeping all wrestlers in the bleacher areas when they are not wrestling. Aisles in the gymnasium must be kept clear at all times.

Referees also want coaches to be reminded that there are only two (2) coaches in the corner. No more than 2 at any time! No exceptions!

Concessions: Concessions will be available to spectators but must be eaten in designated area. Food and drink is not allowed in the gym (except for athletes on floor)

T-Shirts: Tournament T-shirts and sweatshirts will be available for purchase throughout the tournament with GSHL 2A Logo.

Girls will be able to use the boy's locker room near the main gym. Do not leave valuables unattended in the locker room or any other location in the building

Bus Parking: After drop-off, please park school buses on the south side of the school, near the baseball & Soccer field.

Medical: There will be a certified athletic trainer at the tournament. Each area will have a blood clean-up station. In the case of any major injury, our fire district is two blocks from the high school. Any 9-1-1 call would be handled by our supervising administrator

Filming/Video: All filming must be done from the balcony above the gym. Standing in front of spectators or being alongside the wrestling mats will not be allowed. The only mat side recording allowed is done by a 1 team manager in the teams corner behind or next to the coaches.
