Seeding preparations:

Regional entries - All rosters and varsity win/loss results must be submitted in the Trackwrestling database prior to 7:00 p.m. MST on Wednesday, February 5th, 2025.

Regional criteria – (head-to-head, previous state placer), must be entered between Wednesday, February 5th at 7:01 p.m. MST and Thursday, February 6th at 7:00 p.m.

Seeding Criteria:

Below is a summary of the seeding criteria. The 2024-2025 CHSAA wrestling Bulletin is the source of truth for regional seeding.

1. Returning State Champion - state placer (higher place has preference)-any previous years.
 - a. If two place winners from different weights were in the same classification and finished in the same place, the higher-weight class wrestler has precedence.
 - b. If two place winners are from different classifications, the larger classification has precedence.
2. Returning state qualifier. In the case of multiple state qualifiers, the following will be used as the order of preference.
 - a. Higher regional place
 - b. If two place winners from different weights were in the same classification and finished in the same place, the wrestler at the higher weight class has precedence.
 - c. If two place winners are from different classifications, the larger classification has precedence.
3. Place wrestlers in order (1-16) by win percentage listed in Trackwrestling. Once the order is established, use head-to-head comparisons must start at the top (#1 position) and work your way down. 15 match minimum. Wrestlers with fewer than 15 matches will be assessed losses to get to the 15-match minimum.
4. Most wins.
5. Varsity win percentage at the weight the wrestler is entered in at the regional meet.
6. Most falls
7. Most technical falls
8. Most major decisions in overall varsity record.

Site Director:

Seeded Wrestlers by weight class will be released on Thursday, February 6th by 9:00 PM to coaches for review of accuracy and to request necessary changes before Friday's weigh in.

All wrestlers will be bracketed before the 1:00 PM coaches' meeting on Friday, the 7th. We will verify the brackets for all weights at the 1:00 PM coaches' meeting.

After weigh-ins, we make the necessary changes to the brackets if needed and release them to the public.

All coaches must have all varsity weigh-in sheets available at the regional seeding meeting. They must also have the signed CHSAA Wrestling Physician's Clearance Form certifying the assessment for any wrestler below the 12% body fat limit.

After submitting rosters, a wrestler may only be replaced, not moved. Coaches are not permitted to replace wrestlers for any reason other than injury or illness to the entered wrestler or administrative withdrawal from the tournament, such as academic ineligibility or disciplinary action taken by the school involving the entered wrestler. A wrestle-off for a position after the rosters are submitted is not a valid administrative withdrawal.

Requirements and expectations:

During the regional, coaches should dress appropriately with a standard of professionalism. Full-length pants (Khaki preferred), a collared shirt or a school-issued top with the school's name or logo (collar preferred), and athletic shoes or dress shoes are appropriate. All apparel must be in good repair. No hats, shorts, flip-flops, or sandals are permitted. High heels should not be worn on mats.

During regional and state competitions, a maximum of two team personnel (coaches and/or non-participating contestants) will be permitted on chairs at the edge of the mat.

To highlight the wrestlers' efforts in competition, the floor area at all regional and state tournament events should be clear of coaches and wrestlers who are not competing then.

Weight Allowance

The 2-pound growth allowance was implemented on January 1, 2025. Further, an additional pound will be given for the Saturday of the regional wrestling tournament.
