

4th Annual Golden Eagle Girls Invitational

FORMAT:

We will run 5 mats at Fergus High School.

Friday and Saturday will be a double elimination - bracketed tournament.

2nd CHANCE:

All girls eliminated from the tournament, once the fourth round has been completed, will be placed into pools to try and get them additional matches. This will start at 9:00 AM Saturday.

SCHEDULE: We will run ahead of schedule if time permits.

Friday January 24, 2025

Coaches/Seeding meeting - 10 AM

Round 1 - 11:00 AM - First round championship

Round 2 - 2:00 PM - Second round championship and first round consolation

Round 3 - 5:00 PM - Second round consolation

Round 4 - 6:00 PM - Third round consolation

Saturday January 25, 2025

Round 5 - 9:00 AM - Semis (2 mats) and 2nd Chance round robin (3 mats - run straight through)

Round 6 - 10:30 AM - Consolation semis (2 mats) and continue 2nd Chance round robin (3 mats)

Round 7 - 1:00 PM - Placing matches - fifth/sixth - mat 3, third/fourth - mat 1, and first/second - mat 2

Finals matches will go in the following order - 100, 235, 105, 190, 110, 170, 115, 155, 120, 145, 125, 140, 130, 135

We will wrestle the first five placing matches, then do awards for all five weights, then wrestle the next five placing matches, then do awards for those five weights and then wrestle the last four matches and then do awards for the last four weights. Then do team awards.

3. Girls State tournament placing 2023
4. Golden Eagle Girls Invite placing 2023
5. Girls State Tournament placing 2022
6. Golden Eagle Girls Invite placing 2022

Make sure to enter seeding information when registering girls.

We will wrestle through 6th place, however, awards will only be given to the top 3.

All changes need to be updated on Trackwrestling by 8:30 AM Friday.

TRACK WRESTLING:

WEIGHT CLASSES:

Weight classes will follow the MHSA guidelines.

Weight classes will be 100, 105, 110, 115, 120, 125, 130, 135, 140, 145, 155, 170, 190, 235.

The January +1 lb. growth allowance will be in effect and an additional +1 lb. will be added to Friday's weigh in.

WEIGH-INS and SKIN CHECKS:

Weigh-ins will be conducted in accordance with the MSHA and NFHS rules. Each team will conduct their own team weigh-in Thursday night after 4 PM with an approved administrator from the school.

For Saturday's competition a wrestler on Friday will be allowed to weigh in for the next day of competition starting Friday at 5PM or after their last match after 5PM. (with a +1 growth allowance) There will be an announcement when girls are ready to be weighed in.

Weigh-ins will close for all weight classes one hour after the last match of the day on Friday. There will be a team skin check Friday morning.

LOCKER ROOMS:

There will be two locker rooms open for girls to use. Towels will not be provided.

HOSPITALITY ROOM:

CONCESSIONS:

Concessions will be provided by Fergus Wrestling Club.

AWARDS:

Medals will be given to the top 3 girls in each weight class. There will be two divisions for team trophies this year, large and small. We will give out team trophies for the top 3 teams in each division.

Large teams will be teams with 11 or more wrestlers and small teams will be teams with 10 or less wrestlers.

Large teams will score their top 14 wrestlers regardless of weight classes.

Small teams will score their top 6 wrestlers regardless of weight classes.

Outstanding Wrestler - We will give out one outstanding wrestler award which will be voted on by the head coaches from each school.
